The EUChinaGRID 1st Conference will present the vision of cross-national infrastructures as a driving force towards widening the European Research Area and creating a global, virtual space for Research.

Due to the swift and impressive growth becoming increasingly rapid in the last few years, China is nowadays regarded as a key partner in Science and Technology: the EUChinaGRID initiative is thus strategically intended to strengthen the existing bonds among the European and Chinese scientific community and to promote the creation of new ones, ultimately pursuing the extension of such collaboration to Industry.
